

Student Visa (Research) Checklist

**** Applicants are requested to submit and upload ALL the documents even if it is optional choices ****

Section A: Standard Documents

- ❑ **PhD course Admission Letter** and **Certificate of Affiliation** from the recognized Indian institution/university.
[!] **Interview is required**
- ❑ Undertaking Letter (with sign and issue date)
- ❑ Bank guarantee or statement - The issue date must be within 1 week at the time of submission.
- ❑ A statement of minimum cost during the academic period (including tuition, stay, and living expenses)
- ❑ If you visit for the purpose of an exchange research or an invited researcher as a professor other than a doctoral program, it may differ from the above information. Please prepare all the documents and visit the center. All the result are decided by the embassy.

- New visa regulations (since *Jan 2022*)

Section B: Additional documents based on specific conditions

Condition 1: For family members

- A Spouse and/or children of a Research Visa applicant are eligible for Dependent Visa. Please refer to Dependent Visa Checklist to know about required documents. The child accompanying their parents is eligible for up to 17 years old.

Section C: Important Reminders

Please note **the validity of the visa begins from the date of issue** (NOT from the date of arrival in India)

Visa fees and other service fees cannot be refunded once your application is submitted.
